LPHOA Board Elections

Do you know what qualifications are required to become a LPHOA Board Member? Qualifications include....

- * Resident connected to the LPHOA public water system for at least (1) year.
- * LPHOA member in good standing.
- * Shall have attended a minimum of (4) meetings during the fiscal year.
- * Only one member of an immediate family living in the same household shall hold elective office.

The LPHOA President will appoint a Nominating Committee to make recommendations of qualified members for election in November. Any LPHOA Member in good standing may nominate a qualified member for elective office.

2015 Outside Water Use Regulations

During the period between May 15 – September 15, or as otherwise specified by the LPHOA Board of Directors, the sprinkling of lawns and gardens, or ANY outside water usage, shall be limited in the following manner:

Washington, Park and 41st Streets - Monday, Wednesday, Friday
Ogden, Liberty Blvd. and Williams Street - Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday
The above streets have outside water use privileges only on the days and hours stated.
Days will alternate each year and there is NO SUNDAY USE. More than one hose, sprinkling systems and LPHOA water individual storage tanks ARE PROHIBITED.
Sprinkling cans filled at the spigot may be use anytime. No other special permits will be issued. Anyone violating these regulations shall be assessed a fine of \$25.00 for the first violation, subsequent violations will be \$50.00 for each violation. These fines are subject to change depending upon water conditions prevailing. NO WARNINGS WILL BE GIVEN. Fines will be added to the LPHOA Maintenance Assessment.

LPHOA Maintenance Assessment

Starting January 1, 2016 the late charge for the maintenance assessment, which is billed quarterly, will be changed to 10% of the outstanding balance instead of the current \$6.00 late charge. This will not take effect until the 1st quarter of 2016. If you have a current outstanding balance, you will have until December 31, 2015 to pay the balance in full to avoid the new late charge fee.

Parking

There is no parking at any time on Liberty Park streets 2:00 a.m. - 6:00 a.m. There is also no overnight parking at the Liberty Park Community Building or the park.

Garbage

Just a reminder, for those who previously had garbage pick-up on Monday the garbage pick-up has been changed to Tuesday. Please place garbage out by the curb on Monday instead of Sunday.

CCR

The Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) were mailed to each homeowner on the LPHOA water system along with the 3rd quarter maintenance assessment. Keep this report, it may be needed for real estate or financial dealings regarding your property.

Mosquito Prevention

With the abundance of rain we've had lately, prevent mosquito breeding by removing stagnant water and changing your bird bath frequently.

BBQ Grilling Safety Tips
