Spring Maintenance

B-Box

The buffalo box (B-Box), an emergency outside water shut-off valve, is located in your front yard. LPHOA paints these important boxes blue and they must be kept visible. LPHOA replaces at no charge any missing or broken covers. If your cover needs replacing, please contact us. If the B-Box sleeve is full of debris, dirt, etc. it is the homeowners' responsibility to clean it out. LPHOA will not clean these boxes unless it involves a delinquent shut-off and then the cost is charged to the homeowner.

Sump Pump

With rainy season upon us, now is the time to check your sump pump. Take appropriate caution when working around water and electricity, do a run/check test now. If after cleaning maintenance the pump still does not run, perhaps it's tired and needs to be replaced. Our area is often affected by power outages, especially during severe thunderstorms so a battery powered backup sump pump should be considered. Do not direct your sump pump discharge towards or on your neighbor's property.
